


### RBC, Hgb, and Hematocrit

- Doctor will look at these together.
- RBC is Red Blood Cells
- Men = 4.7–6.1 million per microliter
- Women = 4.2-5.4
- RBC x 3 should equal Hgb
- Hgb is Hemoglobin
- Hematocrit is the % of RBCs.
- Men = 41%-50%
- Women = 36%-48%

## **RDW** 11.9 – 15.5


- Fatigue.
- · Shortness of breath.
- Joint pain.
- Tenderness in the palms of the hands or soles of the feet.
- Itching skin, particularly after a shower or bath.
- Sleep disturbance.




#### Bilirubin









#### Globulin

### **LDH** 135 - 214

- Used as a marker of tissue breakdown
- Abundant in red blood cells
- Can function as a marker for hemolysis.
- Can indicate lymphoma
