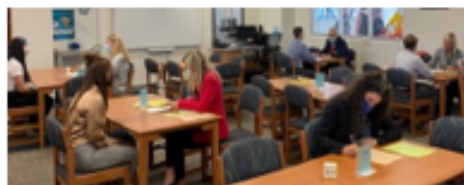


A*S*K Ethical Leadership Certification
