Pitches / Facilities

We've had some issues with joy riders gaining access via the Common Lane car park and driving over the Plateau pitch on 3 occasions since June, which in turn has damaged the pitches after we have spent money on trying to improve them. We are looking to get some new signs printed to remind people not to park in the car park when football isn't taking place and that the gates will remain locked.

Bents Green School has access to the car park during the week as an overflow car park and the caretaker opens them in a morning and SHOULD lock them in the evening. We will be talking to the Council about how we can improve this situation.

If you are the last one leaving the car park on a match day, please check that the gates are locked behind you. It would be appreciated by all concerned.



We appreciate the grass hasn't been cut on regular occasions by the council this summer which has caused some frustrations with the teams. We are looking to see if we can afford a private contractor company to help do this for us and move away from unreliable Council promises. We will update you in future editions. If anyone knows of any contactors which could help us in this area, please get in touch with us.

Our planning permission for the new container in the Common Lane car park should be concluded by the next edition and we will let you know the outcome of their decision.

Just a reminder that the new goals have locking pins on them, so if you help take down the goals at the end of the game, please can we make sure the pins are left stored in the base bar and in the cross bar after taking the goals down so we don't lose them. The bars should be left on the floor to one side of the pavilion corridor. We have already had to purchase a number of replacements and the season is only two months old.

Also, when placing the goals back behind the pavilion, can we kindly remind people to use the locks around the posts to keep them secure, we have noticed on more than one occasion that the locks have been left unsecure. We don't want them to go walkies......

Reminder

We have also engaged meetings with Work Ltd/Hidden Gem about improving our relationship. They own the car park next to the pavilion, so we are actually 'guests' in their car park on match days. This is their main source of income to support Work Ltd (the charity for adult students with learning disabilities).
