## **Early Schools in Greene**

In the Virginia Report of Schools<sup>1</sup> for August 1, 1886 to
July 31, 1887 the Superintendent of Schools for Greene County
for the year was George B. Jennings<sup>2</sup> of Ruckersville. The only
other school officials noted were nine trustees who were not
named. In his annual report, Mr. Jennings indicates the board
of trustees "met only as business required."<sup>3</sup>

The report records 899 white students and 265 colored students for a total of 1164<sup>4</sup> enrolled during 1886-87. Of the school age population, only 62 per cent of white children and 35 per cent of colored children were enrolled. The average monthly enrollment per teacher for Greene County was 30 pupils.

The total number of schools for Greene County was 31, 25 white schools and 6 colored. Thirteen male teachers and eighteen female teachers were listed for the school year of 1886-87. The average monthly salary for male teachers was \$21.52 and for female teachers \$22.21.

A Virginia Public School Register covering the years 1886-96 records the session of a school or schools in Stanardsville District #9 and offers insight into the duration of sessions and the families represented in the student population. Efforts to locate the site of Public School #9 have been unsuccessful although it is believed to have stood at some distance north of Stanardsville near South River.

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Like most, if not all, other schools in Greene County at this time, school #9 was undoubtedly a one-room school. An 1891 inventory of school furniture lists one axe, a bucket and dipper, a stove, and seven desks.

Edith McMullan kept the school in the year 1887. She was born on 13 February 1868 and died 10 June 1950, her entire life being spent in Greene County. She was a daughter of Hiram A. and Alberta Melone McMullan and married Marcellus Walker Runkle.

The following is a transcription of the original school register for the year 1887 from January until June. The list consists of student names, ages and number of days attended as recorded by the teacher, Edith McMullan.
