## **Direct Behavioral Observation Guidelines**

On garycates.net you will find three forms for data collection. These include a frequency count form, an Antecedent Behavior Consequence Log, and a Behavioral Observation From. Each of these forms have very different uses and for maximum success should be used together as you complete a behavioral evaluation. Table 1 displays a general framework for who, when, why and how across the three types of direct behavioral observations.
