OUTINGS:

- 1. Parents offer to lift.
- 2. Teachers allocate the children to each car.
- 3. This list is given to the Front Office.
- 4. Teachers take class files with them on the outing.
- 5. Parents meet at the bottom end of the ring road.
- 6. Car checks are done.

SPORT OR ANY OTHER EVENTS/MATCHES:

- 1. Parents offer to lift.
- 2. Staff allocate the children to each car.
- 3. Parents meet in the hall quad/ ring road.
- 4. All parents have been sent the criteria needed if they help with transport. (See below).

Parents transporting children to any events organized by the school must ensure that:

- 1. Their vehicle is roadworthy.
- 2. Their vehicle has a valid license displayed.
- 3. Their vehicle's tires are in good condition.
- 4. Their vehicle has working lights.
- 5. Their vehicle has seatbelts for all the passengers (no sharing).
- 6. The driver has a valid driver's license.

*NO smoking in the car while lifting, and NO consumption of alcohol if you are transporting children.

*Staff and parents who volunteer to transport children/adults by using their own vehicles on behalf of the school, cannot be held liable for any injuries/loss of life/damage to self or property. The school is also exempt from the above mentioned.
