A quick reminder about our medication policy:

Please send medication to school only when imperative. Ask your physician to prescribe dosage times other than school hours if possible.

At no time may medications be brought into the child's classroom in his/her lunch bag or backpack.

A medication request form, found in the front office, must be filled out and signed by the parent or legal guardian before the school may administer medications. No medication can be dispensed without this form. Medications must be in their original container. Review our full policy in the Parent handbook.

Reminder: Please only send water or unflavored milk as drinks. Juice, soft drinks, Gatorade are not allowed and are reserved for parties or special occasions.
