Trees and Perennials Criteria

The following criteria are used in the selection of approved trees and perennials for the RCCTA.

- Low susceptibility to common insects
- Resistant to common diseases
- Low maintenance
- Minimal suckering
- Not considered "dirty" or a nuisance due to dropping of seeds, fruits, sticks, etc.
- No potential of causing collateral damage such as heaving sidewalks, roots under foundations, etc.
- Stronger trunks and branches to better resist wind, hail, etc. falls and breakage and subsequent clean-up and property damage costs

• Appropriate size to surroundings (bigger trees in common areas, 20'-25' maximum size near homes), resulting in less damage potential; less cost to trim, remove and replace; and attractive landscaping impact

- Low susceptibility to deer and rabbit munching
- Zone 3-4 appropriate

• Lists reflect species diversification – e.g. use of a variety of tree types to avoid catastrophic loss of one species because of unforeseen disease, etc., and subsequent replacement cost to Association
