- 1. Address all attendees in a kind and respectful manner.**
- 2. Follow the agenda.**
 - You may submit agenda items in advance of the meeting if you do not see your concern listed in the preliminary published agenda.
 - The board has arranged the agenda so topics that are the most urgent and affect the most members are first.
 - Any new topics presented from the floor will be addressed at the end of the meeting.
- 3. Speak no more than three minutes** if you have comments and questions.
- 4. Remember that we are neighbors, and your board members are volunteers.**

The Red Cedar Canyon Townhouse Association Board of Directors has received feedback from some association members that they do not attend the annual meeting because of behavior they have witnessed from some members in prior years.

Therefore, the association board has adopted the above code of conduct in an effort to improve both attendance and the tone of the meeting.
