RESOLUTION 2023-09

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWBERRY (“NEWBERRY TOWNSHIP”) LOCATED IN YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROGRAM (“RACP”) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION RELATING TO THE MULTI-USE EMERGENCY SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION PROJECT; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS BETWEEN NEWBERRY TOWNSHIP AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AND CERTAIN OTHER DOCUMENTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Budget notified Newberry Township that the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has authorized the release of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) in RACP funds (the “Grant”) for certain construction activities associated with the Multi-Use Emergency Services and Construction Project (the “Project”) and has requested the Township prepare and submit a formal and complete RACP application to the Office of the Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Grant application and the Grant Agreement on behalf of the Township and to execute any other documents necessary to effectuate receipt of the Grant for the Project.
