

Newberry Township Parks R E N T A L S

Shelley Park: Located at the southern end of the Township, Shelley Park, donated by Buck and Katie Shelley, is 36 acres with three ball fields, a 1/3 mile nature trail, 1/2 mile macadam pedestrian trail, a basketball court, a large youth playground, tot lot, concession stand and three pavilions.

Fireplace Pavilion: located in the North section of the park, this pavilion contains two charcoal grills, electric and a two-sided fireplace. This pavilion can seat approximately 100 people / 10-12 tables and is 30' x 50'. It may be rented for \$50.00/resident or \$100.00/non-resident.

Ball Fields: there are two Little League Fields and one fenced T-ball field. These may be reserved at \$25.00 per day.



Terry Dolan Memorial Park: Located at the southern end of the Township on Cly Road, adjacent to Goldsboro Borough and the Susquehanna River, the Park has one large pavilion with seating for up to 100 people, charcoal grills, one adult league baseball field, a basketball court, a tot lot and electric. The land was donated by “The Friends of Cly.”

Pavilion: this pavilion contains two charcoal grills, electric and one portable toilet. It can seat approximately 100 people and is 30' x 50'. The pavilion may be rented for \$50.00/resident or \$100.00/non-resident.

ADA accessible picnic tables are available in each park and can be provided in the pavilion upon request (at least one week prior notice is required.)

All reservations must be paid in full two weeks prior to use.
