RESOLUTION NO. 2023-16

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
NEWBERRY PROVIDING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2023 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, Newberry Township (“Township”) is a second class township duly organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township adopted a budget for the calendar year 2023 on December 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code Article XXXII, Section 3202(e) authorizes the Supervisors to, by Resolution, make supplemental appropriations for any lawful purpose from any funds on hand or estimated to be received within the fiscal year not otherwise appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to establish a Fire Tax Fund with funds collected under the Fire Tax; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 General Fund Budget reflects fire tax funds expected to be in the amount of \$244,750, which shall be moved to the new Fire Tax Fund. This movement of fire tax funds shall result in a reduction of income of \$128,750 and expense of \$116,000 in the 2023 General Fund Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, to make the following supplemental appropriations from the General Fund for the 2023 budget for the Township:

SECTION 1. An appropriation for the establishment of the Fire Tax fund from all fire tax funds reflected in the 2023 General Budget shall be created.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
