A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWBERRY PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL TO TRANSFER RESERVE ACCOUNT FUNDS TO THE TOWNSHIP'S PLGIT INTEREST BEARING ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, Newberry Township ("Township") is a second class township duly organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township currently has Reserve Funds currently invested in a Public Funds Money Market with Traditions Bank; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code Article XXXII, Section 3204 authorizes the Supervisors to allow for Township funds to be held in savings accounts or time deposits; and

WHEREAS, the Township now desires to move \$424,075.27 of the Township's Reserve Account(s), which are currently held at Traditions Bank to the Township's PLGIT Interest Bearing Account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Newberry Township, to do the following:


SECTION 1. Move \$424,075.27 of the Township's Reserve Account(s), which are currently held at Traditions Bank to the Township's PLGIT Interest Bearing Account.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.



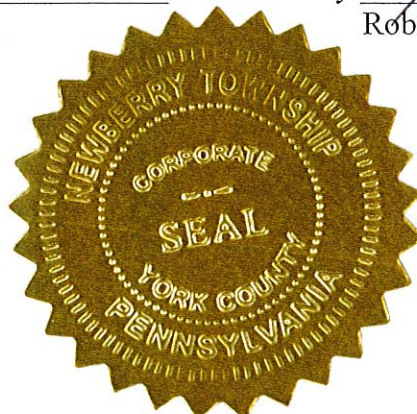
