## **CDCTS Annual MEETING MINUTES, March 10, 2020**

#### I. Call to order

President Jean Sullivan called to order the regular meeting of the CDCTS Board at 7:00 p.m. on March 10, 2020 at RJ's Courtyard, Alcoa, TN.

Before the meeting was formally begun, Jean Sullivan introduced a guest, Bethany Powers. She is a photographer and has offered to take pictures of riders/horses at any of our shows. She handed out her business card and she stated that she is available anytime.

#### II. Roll Call

President Jean Sullivan conducted the roll call. The following board members were present: Jean Sullivan, Marge Williams, Carolyn Ordal, Alece Ellis, Carol Mitchell, Jeannie Baggett and Kennetha Eikelberg. The following Board members were absent: Jill Strain and Susan Hill. The following CDCTS members were in attendance: Janice Butt, Carol Grau, Julie Hall, Shaelyn Baggett, Julie Noe, and Susan Michaud. Guests: Charlie Grau, Alan Kenner, and Bethany Powers.

#### III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Minutes from February 11, 2020 were sent electronically via newsletter to all members for their review. A motion to accept the minutes as read by Alece Ellis and was seconded by Carolyn Ordal.

#### IV. Committee Reports

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>. Jill Strain was absent. Jean Sullivan presented the financials. The balance in the CDCTS checkbook is \$17,913.87. Carol Mitchell made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and was seconded by Alece Ellis.

#### Show Committee.

- a. <u>Spring School Show 2020</u>. Will be held on Saturday, May 2, 2020 at Penrose Farm. Laura Wolfe, L Graduate with Distinction, Clinton, TN will be the judge at this show. We will request that Erica Adams setup the jump combos, etc, like last spring's show. Marge Williams brought up the issue of the Coggins not matching the entry forms. Marge Williams stated that both names need to match. The Coggins need to be provided with the entry form. There was a discussion that a copy of the Coggins should be produced at the gate when entering the show grounds, for the safety of all participants and horses. Carolyn Ordal suggested that the shows should be advertised at least 30 days before the date to give more exposure for CDCTS. To increase the show's entries, it was suggested by Shaelyn Baggett that it be advertised on Facebook, Instagram, flyers, barns, etc. and on CDCTS' website.
- b. <u>Volunteer Coordinator</u>. Jean Sullivan stated that we need a Volunteer Coordinator for the Spring Show. If anyone would like to be the volunteer, please see Jean Sullivan.

<u>Health and Wellness Committee</u>. Janice Butt went to the UT Horse Seminar on March 7, 2020. It was conducted from 8 a.m. till 5 p.m. She found it very interesting and learned a lot.

#### V. Old Business.

Jean Sullivan reiterated that CDCTS will retain Riding High as the club's annual project. Jeannie Baggett stated that Riding High is very appreciative of the items we sent them. Riding High said that they need the following items: vet wrap, Quest Plus and Panacur wormers, duct tape, Equinox, Pergolide medications, ASTM rated riding helmets (children and adults) medium size with flexible brim, and items to replenish the first aid kit. She will get a list of items that were used. She suggested that the club should approach Smart Pak for them to donate items.

#### VI. New Business.

<u>Photographer</u>. Shaelyn Baggett suggested that we have a photographer at all the shows and post them on the website and Facebook page. She suggested that individuals could buy photos as well. We need to have good media before and after the shows to get the word out about CDCTS.

Non-Profit Status. Kennetha Eikelberg suggested the club buy Legal Zoom to create the paperwork for CDCTS' maintaining a non-profit status. She said that it would cost \$400.00 to establish our status through this company. She said that all costs can be written off. Legal Zoom will provide legal assistance for questions that the club may have. She stated that it would cost an additional \$159.00 to get a registered agent for the club and that this amount is also for accounting counseling. She spoke with Karen of the Georgia dressage group and found out how they did it. Carol Mitchell said that a cost-benefit analysis should be conducted before we approach Legal Zoom and what they provide. Jean Sullivan stated that we should have a Study Committee look into the benefits of having a non-profit status and requested those interested should contact her.

Membership. Shaelyn Baggett stated that we need to get more members to join CDCTS. We should see what the riders are looking for. She suggested we contact prior members and find out their interest in becoming club members. Carol Mitchell stated that in the past year, Jill Strain sent out letters previously and received a poor response. Additionally, many of the letters came back as their addresses were incorrect. Shaelyn Baggett said that she will find other barns to get in touch with regarding getting new people to become members. Julie Hall suggested that to entice new members that they not be charged the membership fee when they enter their first show. Alece Ellis suggested that all non-members when entering a show should be asked at that time if they want to become a member. Jeannie Baggett suggested that as a new member, that CDCTS give back the fee at year end awards.

#### **Competitor Information**

#### Entries:

All entries MUST include a copy of a current negative Coggins. The CDCTS/Penrose Farm release form must be filled out, signed and dated by rider and/or parent or guardian if rider is younger than 18 years old. Stallions are permitted to show at Penrose Farm.

Payment in full must accompany the entry form. If payment has not been received by closing date of Saturday April 25, 2020, the entry will be void. Payment by PayPal is also accepted. If you choose to use PayPal, make sure you add \$2.00 to your total fee and scan or print a copy of your payment receipt and send it with your completed and signed show entry form so that the Show Secretary can confirm your payment.

#### Refunds:

No cash refunds *after closing date*. Show credit will be given with a veterinarian's or a doctor's certificate/letter. RETURNED CHECKS for NSF will incur a \$40.00 fee and a void entry.

#### Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place

#### Arena

All Dressage Tests will be ridden in the Covered outdoor arena. Footing is sand and GGT. Warm up area will be in an outdoor sand ring and will be marked.

Dressage tests Intro, A, B, C and CT dressage tests "Green As Grass," "Elementary Novice," and Preliminary Test A will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena. All other dressage tests, including the following CT tests—Preliminary Test B and Intermediate A and B—will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena.

Jumping will be in a fenced-in outdoor arena. Footing is sand.

#### Attire:

Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. ASTM-SEI approved helmets and appropriate footwear is required and must be worn at all times when mounted.

#### Parking:

Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in a signed area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas**.

#### Ride Times:

Official ride times will be posted on the CDCTS website and FaceBook page on Thursday April 30, 2020 after 6 pm.

**Day Stalls:** may be available. Owners of those horses using day stalls must show proof of a flu shot within the last three (3) months, current vaccinations and negative coggins. For availability and cost please contact Erika Adams via text at 865-384-5680 or email adams.erika@gmail.com

## CDCTS Schooling Shows - General Rules

## CDCTS Schooling Shows General Rules

All shows are run under the general rules of USEF, unless otherwise specified.

Approved protective headgear and footwear with appropriate heels must be worn whenever mounted.

All schooling shows offer current: USDF Introductory Levels, USEF Training through Fourth Level, FEI levels, Rider tests, USEA Eventing tests, Pas de Deux and Musical Freestyles (all levels)

It is expected that riders take pride in their turnout. Coats are encouraged, but not required. Plain white riding shirts or polo-style shirts with dark breeches are also appropriate. T-shirts or tank tops are not permitted. Note: during hot weather, riders are encouraged to show without coats in the interest of their health.

Braiding the mane is encouraged, but not required.

The following equipment is forbidden at a dressage show: martingales of any kind; bearing, side or running reins; seat covers; and any form of blinkers.

The following equipment is permitted in warm-up areas: running martingales, bandages, boots and side reins

All equipment, including whips, bits and spurs must comply with USEF rules.

Ear nets are permitted; fly masks are not allowed.

No bareback riding is allowed.

A rider should not be judged by anyone who has instructed him/her within the last 30 days (exception: attending clinics). If you arrive at the show and find that your instructor has been substituted for the judge, notify the show manager and ask to ride *hors concours*, or don®ride and receive a full credit for your entry fees.

If you are riding a musical freestyle, please bring your own music and boom box.

Check your score before you leave the show grounds. Any scoring errors must be reported and corrected before you leave the show grounds. After that time, no corrections can be made.

Please note that classes do not always go in order of lowest to highest. Classes at shows may be scheduled in any order throughout the day.

## CDCTS Schooling Shows - General Rules - Continued

Classes may be split or combined, depending on the number and distribution of entries. If you intend to bring a horse that is not competing onto the show grounds, this decision must be cleared with the show manager prior to the show date, and will be at his/her discretion. If permitted by the manager, you must bring a current negative Coggins test to the show grounds and present it to the manager upon your arrival, before you unload your horse and also pay the non-competition fee. Please see the entry form for details.

#### **Show Etiquette**

Be considerate of other riders in the warm-up area. Pass left-shoulder to left-shoulder and yield to those who are moving at faster gaits.

Arrive outside the ring approximately one minute before your ride time, having already warmed up your horse. You will have 45 seconds to enter the ring once the judge has rung the bell.

If your ride is not next, please do not congregate with your horse around the arena entrance.

Lunging is prohibited in the warm-up area; check with the show manager or warm-up ring steward about where lunging is permitted on the show grounds.

Be courteous to the judge and show volunteers.

Should you need to excuse yourself from the ring during your test for any reason, be sure to ask for the judges permission prior to exiting the ring.

Leave your trailer site clean; pick up all trash and manure and dispose of it or take it with you. Obey all rules of the facility where the show is held. (for example: where to park, no smoking, no dogs, etc)
