#### III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

## **GUIDELINES FOR VOLUNTEERS AND VOUCHERS**

- 1. Volunteers must sign in and out for volunteer credit. The sign in sheet will be at the show secretaries' desk at the show. The volunteer coordinator will have the list at set-up. If you don't sign in or out, you don't get credit for your volunteer time.
- 2. Eight hours of volunteer work equals one \$10 voucher.
- 3. Voucher is good for all CDCTS clinics and shows and all outside clinics, i.e. Jim Koford etc.
- 4. Volunteer hours count toward year end club volunteer award. The member with the most volunteer hours will win this award.
- 5. Vouchers can be signed over to another person.
- 6. Volunteer hours cannot be signed over to another person.
- 7. Four volunteer hours are required to qualify for year-end awards.
- 8. Upon receiving your voucher, sign your voucher.
- 9. If you donate your voucher to someone else, have that person also sign your voucher.
- 10. If you are using your voucher at a CDCTS sponsored event, turn in your voucher with your show or clinic payment.
- 11. If you are using a voucher for an outside clinic, bring proof of clinic to CDCTS along with voucher and value of voucher will be paid to voucher holder
