THE HORSEMANSHIP IN DRESSAGE



My name is Sloan Adams and I am a horse trainer located in Greenback, TN! I have been training horses for approximately eight years. I got my start training horses when a local rescue asked me to gentle four feral yearlings. This was a big ask for a 10-year-old who knew nothing about training a horse, but I was down for the challenge!

One thing led to another and all four yearlings were gentled and adopted out. This sparked my love for working with feral equine. I continued to work with rescues in the area, gentling their feral/unhandlable intakes to make them more adoptable.

This has since become a specific area of focus in my program. A few years later, I decided that it was time to take my training to the next level and educate myself on the proper development of a horse under saddle. I worked with other trainers in the area, attended clinics, and studied trainers whose morals and training methods aligned with mine. I learned so much but, as all true horsemen and women know, you can never stop learning in the equine world!





Dressage is a discipline I always wanted to try when I was younger,

not for any reason other than I thought it looked cool. As I began learning about developing horses under saddle, I was drawn to the dressage discipline even more, not just because it looked cool, but because dressage develops a foundation that I believe every horse should know: relaxation, balance, suppleness, rhythm, etc.

So, in December of 2022, I decide to begin taking dressage lessons with Susan Hill! Learning the discipline has helped me as a trainer and has helped each horse that comes through my program. Every horse has some form of dressage in their training to create a more relaxed, balanced, and

strong equine under saddle. Not only did dressage help me as a trainer but it has helped me tremendously as a rider. It showed me my weaknesses so I could strengthen them. I have learned much about myself as a rider since starting. Dressage has truly bettered my horsemanship and I feel it can benefit many other riders and trainers as well.

I am very excited for my future in the discipline and am so fortunate to have found an amazing instructor to help guide me through learning dressage. I can say from experience, if you've always wanted to try dressage, do it!! And if you want to learn new ways to become a better rider and horseman, do dressage. You won't regret it!


