CDCTS MEETING MINUTES, MAY 14, 2019

I. Call to order

President Jean Sullivan called to order the regular meeting of the CDCTS Board at 7:00 p.m. on May 14, 2019 at RJ's Courtyard, Alcoa TN

II. Roll call

President Jean Sullivan conducted the roll call. The following Board members were present: Jean Sullivan, Ashley Phillips, Susan Hill, Carol Mitchell, Carolyn Ordal, Jill Strain, Kennetha Eikelberg, Alece Ellis and Jeannie Baggett. The following Board members were absent: none. There was a quorum. The following CDCTS members were in attendance: Caylee Baggett, Janice Butt, Julie Noe, Rita Dunn, Marge Williams, Rosemary Jones, Dave McAdoo, Ashley Crabtree, Susan Michaud, Maria Blackstone, Ariel Blackstone, Carol Grau, Jennifer Miller-Bailey. Visitors: Julie Hall and Charlie Grau.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Minutes from April 9, 2019 was sent electronically via newsletter to all members for their review. A motion to accept the minutes as read was submitted by Kennetha Eikelberg and seconded by Julie Noe. Carried.

IV. Committee Reports

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>. Jill Strain described cash flow for the month and announced the current balance of \$22036.72, which included show revenue. Some costs associated with the show are still outstanding but the show made a good profit. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report by Alece Ellis, seconded by Kennetha Eikelberg. Approved.

Show Committee.

a. <u>Spring Schooling Show 2019</u>. The show went well but got behind when some storms came through around lunch time. Discussion on when to call the show for weather: show will go in rain or shine but if Weatherbug or other weather apps detect lightning between 7-10 miles away, activities will be curtailed until lightning departs the area. Challenges with competitors using PayPal need refining in the following areas: horse name on Coggins must match the name on the application and on the PayPal receipt to avoid confusion. Cut off time for PayPal deposits need to be approximately three days prior to the show in the case of deadline extensions so that the Treasurer can confirm payments are in place prior to the show start. Kennetha Eikelberg can put that restriction in place on the electronic forms and on the club PayPal account once the Show Secretary lets her know of the closing date. The competitors guidance attached to each show application will be changed to reflect these updates.

b. <u>Fall Schooling Show 2019</u>. Date: Saturday, September 28, 2019, held at Winfield Oaks, 433 Meadow Road, Greenback, TN. Judge: Laura Wolfe, L Graduate with Distinction, Clinton TN. Laura Wolfe has offered to donate her fee back to the club. The club approved sending that fee to Riding High in her name. Ashley Phillips will design the jump course. CDCTS jumps will need to be brought to this show. Dave McAdoo volunteered to bring his flat bed trailer to transport the jumps from Jean Sullivan's place to the show. Considering having a trailer inspection at the show which will be at no cost for members and \$25 for non-members.

<u>Eventing Committee</u>. Ashley updated the group on her "Learn to Show" clinic held at Winfield Oaks prior to the spring schooling show. She had approximately 10 attendees who ranged from those who had never shown before to individuals coming back to showing after some time away. She went over the whole horse show process from filling out the forms to what to expect after arriving at the show and show etiquette. She gave each attendee a horse show check list to assist them and all attendees felt confident at the end of the clinic. They all attended the spring schooling show.

<u>Dressage Committee</u>. Rita Dunn presented the updated awards chart for Year End Awards that included dressage, CT, Western and Gaited dressage. She requested clarification on if the club should also have a Year End Award for WE. Maria Blackstone recommended that the Award be a high point, open award that reflects the Combined Dressage and Ease of Handling Scores. Reminder to members: 10 volunteer hours are needed to qualify for Year End Awards.

<u>Membership Committee.</u> Jill Strain has investigated costs and availability of long-sleeved shirts and polos with a local printer and is awaiting a response from the printer. Kennetha is developing a resource page for the website that will list available professionals, barn and horse services in the area and would appreciate any help from members. <u>Health and Wellness Committee</u>. The second quarter lecture will be held by Dr. Hines and will be on equine eye injuries and diseases. Exact location and July 2019 date to be determined. Developing a list of topics and presenters for the remainder of the year and for early 2020.


The Century Club was established at The Dressage Foundation in 1996, at the suggestion of the late Dr. Max Gahwyler, noted dressage judge and clinician. The purpose of The Century Club is to honor senior dressage riders and horses that are still actively riding and competing. In order to become a member of The Century Club, the ages of the rider and horse must add up to 100 or more years! The team must also ride any level dressage test and be scored by a judge.

We are very pleased that Donna Peremya, at the age of 74 ½, rode 25 ½ -year-old NZ Goldboom, known as Boomer, for their Century Club membership during our CDCTS Spring Schooling Show held at Penrose Farm in Knoxville TN.


