From Your President

Our next schooling show is scheduled for June 17 at Walnut Grove Stables in Talbott, TN. This show will be dressage only—classical, western, gaited, combined test dressage and working equitation dressage. Closing date is June 11, so get your entries in! An entry form is in this newsletter. We have a Working Equitation Obstacles Play day in the works for later this summer, our Fall Schooling Show is September 23 and Fall Fun Day at River Glen, the last Saturday in October. Please plan to attend and/or volunteer at CDCTS schooling shows and events.

Summer schooling show volunteers needed include helping the show secretary, ring steward, scribe, set up on Friday and tear down after the show, and concessions. Remember you need 4 hours to qualify for year end awards. Check the February 2023 newsletter for pictures of the ribbons and awards! Your volunteer hours need to be in by November 30, 2023. No exceptions. There are plenty of opportunities to earn your 4 hours between now and November 30.

The board voted to change the voucher program. It was used as an incentive to encourage members to volunteer at our shows, clinics and other events. CDCTS MEETING MINUTES, MAY 9, 2023

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by CDCTS President Carolyn Ordal at 7:00 p.m. on May 9, 2023. The meeting was held at Calhoun's Restaurant, Knoxville, TN.

II. Roll Call

The following board members were present: Carolyn Ordal, Julie Noe, Julie Hall, Lynn Holtman, Kacy Schnake. The following board members were absent: Susan Hill and Rita Dunn. Dave Macadoo was present as a guest member. A quorum was present.

III. Approval of Minutes From Last Meeting

The minutes from April 11, 2023 meeting was provided to all members in the May 2023 newsletter. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Kacy Schnake and seconded by Lynn Holtman. All in attendance voted Yea.

IV. Committee Reports

Treasurer's Report

The treasurer's report was provided by Kacy Schnake. A motion to accept the treasurer's report was made by Lynn Holtman and seconded by Julie Hall. All in attendance voted Yea.

Show Committee

- The Spring Schooling Show was cancelled due to insufficient entries. The April 29, 2023 date conflicted with numerous other well attended events and it was agreed the spring schooling show date should return to the first Saturday in May for 2024, which has been the club's long standing date. A discussion was also had regarding the long-term impact of cancelling schooling shows.
- The June 17, 2023 Summer Schooling Show, dressage only, will go forward. The show secretary will be Carolyn Ordal. Carolyn will consult with Susan Hill regarding obtaining a judge. A "Save The Date" FB post will be sent out. The prize list for the summer schooling show needs to be finalized before publication via social media and email. Kacy Schnake has agreed to look at the on-line show entry programs available to see if it would be beneficial for the club to utilize.
- The Working Equitation Obstacle Play Day tentatively set for June has been postponed at this time. The board will look at a location and date with additional information to follow.
- The Fall Schooling Show is set for September 23, 2023 at Stables At The Mains. A judge is needed.

CDCTS MEETING MINUTES, MAY 9, 2023 - CONTINUED

By-Laws Committee

A lengthy discussion about the proposed changes to the By-Laws was had. The changes were minor in nature and did not impact the major substance of the document. A motion was made to leave the By-Laws in their current state was made by Julie Hall and seconded by Lynn Holtman. All in attendance voted Yea and no changes will be made at this time.

V. Old Business

- An in-depth discussion was had about the voucher program, and all members in attendance took part in the discussion. Pros and Cons of the voucher program were discussed. It was agreed by all in attendance to discontinue the voucher program only, effective immediately. Notice will be sent to all members via email and through the newsletter of this decision. All existing vouchers will be honored through January 31, 2024 and can be used toward CDCTS sponsored events, which now includes the annual banquet. It was agreed the existing vouchers can also be used toward club membership. There was discussion about tracking volunteer hours as well as the scholarship program, and it was decided to leave the scholarship program as it exists for the time being. Further discussion will need to take place regarding tracking volunteer hours as it pertains to year end awards. A motion to accept the changes to the voucher program was made by Julie Hall and seconded by Julie Noe. All in attendance voted Yea.
- A discussion was had about investing in a 9-month CD with Truist Bank. Dave M. gave input and did not see problems with the investment. A motion was made by Lynn Holtman to invest \$5,000.00 from the club checking account into the 9-month CD and seconded by Kacy Schnake.

VI. New Business

- Riding High has inquired if the club will sponsor a horse or otherwise help them this year. The cost to sponsor a horse is \$1,200.00. A lengthy discussion by all in attendance was had about the club's decision last year on how to determine charitable donations. The club is currently in a solid financial position however, the club's prior financial concerns were again discussed. It was agreed Kacy Schnake would investigate the overall event profits for 2022. In the meantime, Dave M. strongly encouraged the club to consider sponsoring a horse for Riding High in 2023. A motion to accept the recommendation to sponsor a horse at the cost of \$1,200.00 was made by Julie Hall and seconded by Lynn Holtman. All in attendance voted Yea.
- Resignations: Dene Masengill has resigned from the BOD effective immediately. Julie Hall has resigned as Secretary on the BOD effective May 31, 2023. A replacement for the Secretary position is desperately needed. Carolyn Ordal will pursue a replacement for the Secretary position which would be through the end of 2023. Any interested person should contact Carolyn Ordal. Carolyn expressed her appreciation for all the help these members have provided through their time on the BOD.

Competitor Information:

<u>Entries</u>: All entries MUST include a copy of a current negative Coggins. The CDCTS/Walnut Grove Stables release form must be filled out, signed and dated by rider and/or parent or guardian if rider is younger than 18 years old. Stallions are permitted to show at Walnut Grove Stables.

<u>USEF Rules State</u>: Horses are limited to a maximum of three Dressage rides per day at Fourth Level and below or two Dressage rides per day above Fourth Level. Horses competing at both Fourth Level and Prix St. Georges, or their equivalents, are limited to two Dressage rides per day.

Payment in full must accompany the entry form. If payment has not been received by the closing date of Sunday, April 23, 2023, the entry will be void. Payment by PayPal is also accepted. If you choose to use PayPal, make sure you scan or print a copy of your payment receipt and send it with your completed and signed show entry form so that the Show Secretary can confirm your payment. On-Grounds Schooling of Horse (non-competing horse)

Competitors who wish to take advantage of this opportunity need to provide a copy of negative coggins, pay the on-grounds fee, a bridle tag fee of \$2.00, and the office fee on or before the closing date. CDCTS and Walnut Grove Stables Hold Harmless Release must be signed as well. When the horse is on the grounds, the bridle tag must be worn at all times.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider. Overall Dressage high point will be awarded for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider.

Arena:

All dressage tests will be ridden in the outdoor arena. Footing is sand and GGT. Warm up area will be in the lower arena and will be marked.

Dressage tests for Classical Intro, A, B, C; \underline{All} Working Equitation, Western Dressage Intro and Basic; \underline{All} CT dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena. All other dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena.

<u>Attire:</u> Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. Schooling show attire is considered a collared shirt with sleeves and appropriate footwear such as paddock boots or tall boots. ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.

Parking:

Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in an assigned area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, park only in designated areas. **Please clean up manure around your horse trailer before leaving for the day**

Ride Times:

Official ride times will be posted on the CDCTS website and Facebook page on Thursday June 15, 2023 after 6 pm.

<u>Day Stalls</u>: will be available on a limited basis. Please contact Dene Masengill @ 423-736-3287 regarding price.

Concessions: Concessions will be available

Dogs: No dogs allowed. No exceptions

Directions to Walnut Grove Stables:

From Knoxville: Take exit 394 off of Interstate 40 onto Hwy 11E towards Jefferson City and Morristown. It is approximately 35 miles to the farm from here. Go through Jefferson City. You will turn off of Hwy 11E onto Lakeshore Rd. Follow Lakeshore Rd. 1.2 miles. The farm drive is the next driveway on the right. Trucks and trailers will turn off of Lakeshore into the field to park. If you are coming in to stable turn up the driveway and go straight to the show barns.

Do not turn onto Tina Circle. GPS may try and turn you there. Not a good idea if you have a truck and trailer...


