II. Roll Call

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Minutes from February 2, 2021 were provided to all members in attendance. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Jean Sullivan and seconded by Mellissa Morehead.

IV. Committee Reports

Treasurer's Report:

A copy of the January Treasurers Report was provided to all members in attendance. A motion to accept the Treasurers Report as presented was made by Alece Ellis and seconded by Melissa Morehead.

Welcome Committee:



We will be introducing other new CDCTS members in upcoming newsletters.




