We will have an "in hand" session, so you can lead your equine partners around and through the obstacles. A good way to show them the obstacles before you ride them. We are also offering small group training sessions taught by Rita Dunn! Entry forms are available on the website and in this newsletter. Spaces are limited, so enter quickly!

Our next schooling show is scheduled for September 23 at The Stables at the Main (formerly Winfield Oaks) in Greenback, TN. Closing date is September 17. This show will be classical, western, & gaited dressage tests, and combined tests with dressage and jumping. Lots of ribbons to be earned, including High Point and Judge's Choice! Entry forms are available on the website and in this newsletter.

If you have vouchers from previous volunteering, you can use them to pay for your entries September 9, September 23 and October 28. Those vouchers expire after the 2024 annual banquet.

Entries:

All entries MUST include a copy of a current negative Coggins. The CDCTS/Stable at the Main release form must be filled out, signed and dated by rider and/or parent or guardian if rider is younger than 18 years old. Stallions are permitted to show at Stable at the Main.

Payment in full must accompany the entry form. If payment has not been received by closing date of September 17, 2023, the entry will be void. Payment by PayPal is also accepted. If you choose to use PayPal, scan or print a copy of your payment receipt and send it via email with your completed and signed show entry form and Coggins so that the Show Secretary can confirm your payment.

Refunds:

No cash refunds *after closing date*. Show credit will be given with a veterinarian's or a doctor's certificate/letter. RETURNED CHECKS for NSF will incur a \$40.00 fee and a void entry.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place. High point ribbons will be given to overall High Point dressage score Youth (under 18), Adult Amateur, Open and Western Dressage. A Judge's Choice ribbon will also be awarded.

Arena:

All Dressage Tests will be ridden in an outdoor arena. Footing is sand and gravel. Warm up area will be marked. There is an indoor arena for warm-up or where horses can be lunged.

Dressage tests for Classical Intro, A, B, C; Western Dressage Intro and Basic; All Combined Training dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena—except for any Intermediate Combined Training tests. All other dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena. Must have at least 5 combined test entries to do the combined tests.

Jumping will be in an unfenced, grassy area.

Attire:

Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. ASTM-SEI approved helmets and appropriate footwear is required and must be worn at all times when mounted.

Parking: Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in an assigned area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas**.

Ride Times: Official ride times will be posted on the CDCTS website and Facebook page on Thursday September 21, 2023 after 6 pm.

From 129S, Turn right onto W Lamar Alexander Pkwy (US-321).

Turn left by the Weigel's (at traffic Light—pass Tractor Supply) onto South Old Glory Rd

Go to Stop sign and Old Glory turns into Big Springs Rd—go straight

Go approximately 5 miles to turn Left on Meadow Rd (sign for Big Spring Presbyterian Church)

Go about 1.2 miles to The Stables at the Main. Farm is on the left. (Across from Crumley Rd) Gate Code is 1899


