A SMALL PIECE OF HISTORY

ANTIQUITY ENCAMPMENT NO 1.

The Oxford dictionary defines" Antiquity" as "Ancientness, old times, especially time before the middle ages." And whilst Members would not claim that the Encampment has subsisted over quite a long period, it has a proud history which can be traced back for over 200 years.

As has been stated previously, a warrant was granted by Thomas Dunkerley in 1791 but, without doubt, Templar activity existed in Bath before that date.

It must be admitted, however, that during the early years there were occasions when the Encampment found it impossible to hold meetings on a regular basis and became dormant. The statutes of 1809, for example, contains a "List of Encampments discontinued from not being able to assemble", and the list includes "The Antiquity of Time Immemorial, Bath". The Encampment was, in fact, revived in 1811 but lapsed again in 1814 and no further meetings were held until 1819. Meetings were then continued until 30th April 1822 when the Encampment once again became dormant and remained so for a period of 33 years. It was finally revived on 15th June 1855, since when it has maintained an unbroken sequence of meetings.
