

Hair Styles/Accessories

Preschool/Kindergarten Classes:

Monday 9:35 (Park Place - ballet) – bun; hair piece on dancers right side

Monday 10:15 (Park Place-ballet) – bun (crest of head); bow on front right side

Monday 3:40 Kindergarten (ballet) – bun; blue bow underneath bun

Monday 6:00 Kindergarten (tap) – ponytail; clip on top of pony

Tuesday 3:10 Kindergarten (tap) – ponytail; dogear headband

Tuesday 5:30 Preschool (tap) – high ponytail; bow on top

Wednesday 9:30 Legacy (ballet) – bun; hairpiece on dancers right side of bun

Wednesday 5:15 Kindergarten (ballet) – bun; hairpiece on dancers right side of bun

Thursday 10:00 Preschool (ballet) – bun; hairpiece on right side of bun

Thursday 1:15 Preschool (tap) – high bun (crest of head) with bun cover

1st-3rd Grade Combination Classes:

Monday 5:00 4th grade tap – high ponytail with scarf

Monday 5:00 3rd grade jazz -high ponytail with scarf and scarf around neck

Tuesday 4:15 1st/2nd grade (jazz) – ponytail; clip on top of pony

Tuesday 4:00 2nd/3rd grade (ballet/tap) – high bun (crest of head); with black ribbon flower attached; Tap – high bun with hair clip

Wednesday 4:00 4th grade jazz – high ponytail; with feather hairpiece on r. side

Wednesday 6:30 2nd/3rd grade (jazz) – high ponytail with scrunchie

Thursday 4:00 2nd/3rd grade (tap/jazz) – high ponytail; hair pouf on r. side of pony (same hairpiece for both dances)

Thursday 5:30 1st/2nd grade (ballet) – high bun (crest of head); hair pouf on right side of head

All ballet classes level I-IV need to have hair in a bun. Bun should be at the crest of the head with a hairnet.

All hair ties, bobby pins, hairnets, etc. need to match the color of your child's hair.

Level I-IV jazz, modern, tap and hip hop classes need to check with their teacher regarding hairstyles for their classes. Many dancers cross over and changing hairstyles multiple times for 1 show may not be able to happen.
