

Are You Saved?

“These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life.” **I John 5:13 NAS**

What's so important about knowing I'm saved and have eternal life? Because I know I'm eternally saved, I don't fear death, knowing that my spirit and soul will immediately be ushered into the presence of God and that my body will be raised and glorified, made fit for eternity. **(II Cor. 5:8 / I Cor. 15)** Knowing I'm saved from the penalty of sin and one day from the very presence of sin, makes me to know that I'm free from the power of sin right now. **(Rom. 6)** That truth makes me free from the self-destructive and cruel practice of sin and enables me to live righteously and enjoy all of its infinite benefits. Knowing I'm saved gives my present life meaning and hope. I'm here for a purpose, to glorify my Savior and point others to Him. **(II Cor. 5:17—21)** As His servant, I know He will supply everything I need in this life. **(Php. 4:19)** All things work together for my good. **(Rom. 8:28)** He will guide me and protect me till I see Him face to face. **(Ps. 23)** Thank God for the power of the shed blood of Jesus Christ that makes me know I'm eternally saved!

“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me.”

Rom 10:9-14

That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.
