

A very special, hard to find little tree with a spectacular display of <u>white feathery</u> <u>blooms</u> from May to November! Also, this is, without a doubt, <u>one of the finest</u> <u>butterfly attractors in the state</u>!!! Mexican Bauhinia forms a large shrub or small tree (single or multi-trunk) depending on our winter temperatures. It's deciduous down to 25 degrees & root hardy down to the high teens. They average 6' tall but can reach 10'-12' tall if protected from a hard freeze.
