Saratoga Gold Yaupon Holly

Ilex vomitoria 'Saratoga Gold'



A <u>yellow</u>-berried version of our native yaupon holly. Tolerant of both drought and poor drainage & can thrive in full sun or any degree of shade. Fairly slow growing. Naturally tends to shrub from the base, but can be pruned to tree form over time. At least seven species of birds eat the berries. They usually wait to eat them until relatively late in the winter when there is not much else left. Usual height 12'-15'. Evergreen.
