A type of Sweet Bay Magnolia, 'Jim Wilson', commonly sold as Moonglow, is a patented cultivar that is distinguished from the species by more vigorous, upright growth, better cold hardiness, and slightly larger flowers. Medium sized tree with an oval to vase-shaped form. Over time can get 35'x18'. Cup-shaped sweetly fragrant creamy 2"-3" white waxy flowers appear in May-June for about one month and sometimes sporadically in the summer. Glossy dark green leaves have a silvery-green underside. Tolerant of clay soil, wet soil and air pollution. Sweet Bay is native to the southeastern U.S. Evergreen in Houston. Semi-evergreen in its northern zones.
