

# 'Desert Museum' Parkinsonia

*Parkinsonia (Cercidium) x 'Desert Museum'*



This tree is a 3 way cross between Parkinsonia microphylla, P. florida and P. aculeata. This fast-growing, **thornless** clone has an upright growth habit. 'Desert Museum' has small, bright green, compound leaves and smooth lime green bark. Its green bark carries on photosynthesis when the leaves are shed during cold or drought. Masses of bright yellow flowers are produced from March through May, with sporadic flowering during the summer months too! Flowers much longer than any of its "parents". Plant in full sun and well-drained soil. Eventual size 25'x25'. Hardy to at least 15 degrees.
