'Desert Museum' Parkinsonia

Parkinsonia (Cercidium) x 'Desert Museum'





This tree is a 3 way cross between Parkinsonia microphylla, P. florida and P. aculeata. This fast-growing, **thornless** clone has an upright growth habit. 'Desert Museum' has small, <u>bright green</u>, compound leaves and smooth <u>lime green bark</u>. Its green bark carries on photosynthesis when the leaves are shed during cold or drought. Masses of <u>bright yellow flowers</u> are produced from March through May, with sporadic flowering during the summer months too! Flowers much longer than any of its "parents". Plant in full sun and well-drained soil. Eventual size 25'x25'. Hardy to at least 15 degrees.
