

Taiwan Cherry 'Double Rosea'

Prunus subhirtella 'Autumnalis Rosea' x *campanulata*



A long blooming hybrid Taiwan Cherry. Fast growing, upright open form, 15'-20', with double magenta-pink flowers. Blooms heavily in the spring before the new foliage emerges, with an additional but lighter bloom cycle in the fall!! Leaves turn yellow before it goes dormant. Fruits are attractive to birds. New leaf growth has a lovely bronze hue. Practically unknown, but worthy of more use.
