Taiwan Cherry 'Double Rosea'

Prunus subhirtella 'Autumnalis Rosea' x campanulata



A long blooming hybrid Taiwan Cherry. Fast growing, upright open form, 15'-20', with <u>double magenta-pink</u> flowers. Blooms heavily in the spring before the new foliage emerges, with an <u>additional</u> but lighter bloom cycle <u>in the fall</u>!! Leaves turn yellow before it goes dormant. Fruits are attractive to birds. New leaf growth has a lovely bronze hue. Practically unknown, but worthy of more use.
