Participant understands that there are inherent risks involved in dealing with horses and ponies and participant understands that: (7) "Inherent risk of an equine activity means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following: (a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; (b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant. Refer to ORC section 2305.321 (A) (7) (a — e)

With full understanding of inherent risks involved in equine activity, some described above, participant to Waive, release and hold harmless Wayne County Saddle Club, its officers and directors and (all) others as defined in ORC 2305.321 from tort and civil liability arising from or related to participation in equine activity as outlined in section 2305.321 of the Ohio Revised Code. The agreement also releases all volunteers, agents, independent contractors and maintenance personnel and others associated with the Event. This waiver agreement is made and entered into in the State of Ohio and shall be enforced and interpreted under the courts and laws of the State of Ohio. It is the participant's sole responsibility to read and understand section 2305.321 of the Ohio Revised code that is available upon request at the entry booth. Note: Participant includes spectators and others attending functions not actually riding or showing a horse.
