



## Signs Your Pet Needs To See the Veterinarian

- ✧ Vomiting
- ✧ Diarrhea
- ✧ Unintended weight loss
- ✧ Change in appetite—decreased or increased
- ✧ Change in normal activity level: lethargy, hyperactivity, or restlessness
- ✧ Limping
- ✧ Sudden inability to move back legs
- ✧ Crying in pain when touched
- ✧ Clumsy or disoriented behavior
- ✧ Seizures
- ✧ Any loss of consciousness
- ✧ Coughing, especially at night
- ✧ Panting in a cat
- ✧ Any difficulty breathing or labored breathing
- ✧ Any blue, purple, or pale hue to the tongue and gums
- ✧ Sudden collapse
- ✧ Excessive drooling
- ✧ Straining in the litter box without producing any urine
- ✧ Crying out while urinating
- ✧ Change in urination: location, frequency, amount, color, smell
- ✧ Bloating abdomen
- ✧ Sneezing excessively
- ✧ Uncontrolled bleeding
- ✧ Nose-bleed or bruising anywhere on body
- ✧ Any unusual odor
- ✧ Hair loss
- ✧ Runny eyes or nose
- ✧ Squinting
