
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REGISTRATION NEWS

If you have a younger child whom you would like to enroll in Heaven Sent for either a 2.5 year old, 3 year old or 4 year old class, please see Mrs. Marsh to fill out a sibling intent form. We will keep it on file until December of the year preceding his/her entry into our program. We currently have a file for siblings who will not be enrolling until September 2025, so it is never too early to sign up!





For our Valentine's Day celebrations (Feb. 13/14) we ask that you do your valentines in the following way: Please have your child sign his or her own name on the valentine (or if they cannot print their own name, print it for them) and put the card in an envelope.


**PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY NAME ON THE FRONT OF THE ENVELOPE-JUST BE SURE TO INCLUDE ENOUGH CARDS FOR THE WHOLE CLASS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME SIGNED ON EACH CARD.

Teaching our little Angels:

We encourage you to have your child take off and put on his/ her OWN coat when you are at home. They are completely capable of doing it-in fact, they do it every day here at school. We simply remind them that it is their job to put on and take off their coats and they do it! It is time to Flipity-Do at home! Our 4 and 5 year olds need this skill for kindergarten! As moms, we know it helps save time for you to "help" them along. Or perhaps you don't even realize that you are taking their coats off of them...but letting them take a hold of this job will do them much good as they grow older.

Other jobs that preschoolers can do: set a table, clear their places after meals, dust table tops, fold towels, pick up toys, make beds, feed pets. Giving children responsibilities like those listed above is beneficial to them, and lets them know that they are part of the family and that families work together.

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DELAYED OPENINGS

- Q) When do you close school or call a delayed opening?
- A) We issue a delay or closing when weather conditions make transportation dangerous. We usually follow what the Hackettstown School District decides during inclement weather.
- Q) How will I know if school is delayed or closed?
- A) You will receive an email and a Remind text if school is delayed or closed. You can also check out the school's Facebook page.
- Q) What if I can't get in to school?
- A) We understand if you prefer not to drive in inclement weather.

OUTDOOR PLAYTIME

We love it when the kids can play outdoors-especially with our wonderful playground. A reminder that if the ground is clear of snow, and the temperature is at or above the 30 degree mark, we'll try to spend at least some time outside. Coats, hats and mittens are a MUST now! Please be sure to send them in with your child every day.



HEALTH ALERT!

It's been really tough out there this school year. Does your child have a slight fever? A runny nose? A bad cough? Are you wondering whether to keep him/her home? You probably should. We do have a definite rule here at Heaven Sent: if your child has had a fever, diarrhea or been vomiting, he/she cannot come to school until 24 (fever-free, diarrhea-free, or vomit-free) hours have passed.
