1. OPEN HOUSE FOR SEWER BOND INFORMATION

Marvin Fielding explained the reasons behind the sewer study, project and the sewer bond election. There was some discussion on the decision behind having a bond election vs a judicial confirmation. Marvin explained that a judge would probably rule that the City could go ahead and bond for the amount needed to complete the project but that going through a bond election lets the citizens have more awareness of the project and costs.
