Solid Waste Collection Guidelines

- **Service Time:** Please have your waste at the curb no later than 7:00 am to ensure collection.
- **Placement:** Place waste in cans, bags, or bundles weighing no more than 50 pounds. Separate your waste from recycle so crews can detect what is intended for each.
- **Containers:** If using garbage cans, use containers between 20 and 96 gallons. Please, no barrels or drums. Waste may also be placed in bags weighing no more than 50 pounds.
- **Freon:** Per Federal law, items containing Freon must be completely drained and have an accompanying ticket verifying Freon has been drained.
- Large Glass: Items such as glass tabletops, shower doors/walls, and entry doors are acceptable up to 5' in length. They must be broken and placed in a box that is secured and marked BROKEN GLASS, or covered vertically and horizontally with duct tape to prevent broken glass from shattering when loaded into the truck.
- **Heavy Trash:** Heavy trash/bulk waste is collected <u>every service day</u>. Please limit your heavy trash to 2 items per service day. Heavy trash/bulk waste includes:
 - Furniture such as couches, tables
 - Mattresses, box springs
 - Appliances such as washers, dryers, dishwashers
 - Hot water heaters
 - Fencing/siding/decking -please remove nails, cut boards into lengths 4' or less, and tie and bundle under 50 pounds; limit 8 bundles per service day.
 - Trampolines please break down and place metal with recycling if possible.
 - Basketball goals break down into sections 4' or shorter; no concrete in base or poles.
 - Carpeting/Flooring: please cut into lengths 4' or shorter and tie and bundle under 50 pounds; limit 8 bundles per service day.
 - Yard Waste: Stack branches at curb in individual piles no larger than 3' high by 3' wide by 3' long with the base of the branches facing the street. While branches need not be tied and bundled, it is strongly encouraged. Branches must be no thicker than 4" in diameter to avoid equipment damage. Limit 8 bundles per service day.

Items NOT ACCEPTED for Regular Collection – the following items can be picked up for a negotiated price; contact Texas Pride at 281-342-8178 for a quote:

- Dirt or Fertilizer
- Waste generated by a private contractor (remodeling, landscaping)
- Rocks or Concrete
- Motor Oil, Gasoline or Kerosene
- Pesticides/Insecticides
- Bricks or Tile
- Batteries
- Paint (liquid)
- Tires
- Pool Chemicals/Chlorine
- Cooking Oil

<u>Holiday Schedule:</u> Solid waste will not be collected on New Year's Day, July 4th, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Collection will roll to the next regularly scheduled service day if service day falls on one of these holidays.
