SATAN DID NOT TALK TO THEM

In the categorical and deliberately preplanned attacked against the newly formed human race; satan did not talk to them he talked to Eve. In this planed attack from satan against Eve, the first thing satan did was to question what God had said. The whole purpose was to get eve to question God's words in her thoughts.

The very first thing Eve did that was wrong was to consider what satan had said. We need to meditate on the scriptures, on the words of God, not on statements against the words of God. In every situation we encounter in life we need to ask ourselves what did God say in His word?

God said - Gen 2:16 Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. KJV

What did satan say? Gen 3:1 Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? (in the form of a question, did God really say, are you sure that's what God said.) The whole point being was to get into Eves head and twist her thoughts. He started the foundation of a thought that it was ok to question Gods word.

God said: Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: satan said Ye shall not eat. Directly opposite of what God said.

The second thing Eve did that was wrong was that she responded to satan in conversation, while considering what satan had said instead of what God had said. She is already beginning to question the words of God and does not even realize it.

Eve says to satan. "Gen 3:2 We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden"

You cannot allow a conversation to get started with our adversary or his cohorts, and never but never get into a conversation about the word of God without using the words of God's Word. The whole purpose of this conversation was to get Eves thoughts away from and out of God's word. What God's word said was - Gen 2:16 Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat.

The third thing Eve did wrong is she left out a word from Gods word. "Gen 3:2 We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden" - Hold on a minute. This is not a proper quote from God. Here Eve is only loosely quoting Gods word. What happened to

the word freely? Any time you don't consider carefully the words that are spoken by God you take the chance of this happening to you.

The record of when Jesus was in the desert and was confronted by satan.

Mathew 4:1 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. 2 And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. 3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. 4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. (Jesus responded to satan's words with God's word. There was no conversation or arguing over what the words of God meant. Jesus quoted God's word in the face of temptation.) 5 Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, 6 And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Satan quotes psalm 91:11, 12 leaving part of God's scripture out of his quote. Again Jesus does not argue or respond to the usage of satan's words. Jesus quotes God's word in the face of temptation.) 7 Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. 8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; 9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. (Again Jesus does not argue or respond to the usage of satan's words. Jesus quotes God's word in the face of temptation.) 10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. 11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Jesus responded to satan with IT IS WRITTEN all three times. Jesus quoted the word in face of temptation. Are we doing the same thing, are responding to temptation with it is written? Or are we responding with: emotions, feelings, religious training?

God says in his word James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

<u>Wherefore lay apart</u> (This starts in our minds); We <u>receive</u> (into our thoughts); Meditate on the scriptures, this is when God teaches us.

Psalm 119:15 I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.; psalm 119:48 My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes. (This meditation is in our thoughts)

In Titus 1:9 God says Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. The words holding fast- mean to hold forth, to hold firmly, to hang on to. This starts in our mind, and in our thoughts. We hold on to Gods word with everything we have. Let nothing mess with what Gods word says. When we starting getting lax on Gods word, when we quit holding on to Gods word with conviction satan, comes after us. It is at this time that satan will try to get into our head. His whole purpose is to steal, kill and to destroy us. Satan wants us out of Gods hands.

Philipians 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; 16 Holding forth the word of life; In the face of confrontation we need to speak forth Gods word in answer to any attack on God's word or against us. IT IS WRITTEN are the three words that will stay our lives in Christ Jesus.

God's word says of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat. Hello Eve, what happened to the word freely? When we start getting lax on Gods word, when we quit holding on to it with conviction, satan gets in our head (not literally but mentally) and gets us to question the words of God.

The fourth thing Eve did wrong was she added a word; "neither shall ye touch it"

Gods word said; Gen 2:16 Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it. Nothing about touching it, we need to be careful about how we handle the word of God. Psalm 138:1 I will praise thee with my whole heart: before the gods will I sing praise unto thee. 2 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. (God magnified His Word above His own name.) His word is worth more to Himself that His own name. God will let nothing stand in the way of His word. In light of this understanding of the importance of God's word, how much should we care about the integrity of God's word?

Eve forgot a word and added a word. She is loosing more of God's word all the time. Satan must have had Eve very flustered, she could not keep her thoughts strait at all.

There is a reason this example of Eve is in the word. We need to learn from this.

The 5th thing Eve did wrong was she changed a word, "lest ye die".

God said, "for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die". Eve has changed the absolute into maybe. Satan has got Eve to completely forget what God has said. She knows she is not supposed to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, but her reasons not to eat of that tree are not Gods reasons not to eat of that tree. The word of God was her only armor against spiritual attacks. We cannot fight satan with our flesh. The flesh does not stand against spirit. She has no more armor left to protect her from the accuser.

You want to be able to stand on Gods side, remember his word. God's word is all we have to protect us from satan.

This is what God said Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Now either Gods word is wrong and God is a liar or our understanding is wrong. Personally I will not bet on God being a liar.

Eve said lest ye die, this means maybe not absolute. satan is messing with Eves head, getting her to change her thoughts. All this was done thru word games. It was by satan's words that Eve considered words other than what God said. Eve changed her thoughts by changing her words.

And the serpent said unto the woman, "Ye shall not surely die." This time emphatically (hey eve, God doesn't know what he's talking about.) he brings a direct contradiction to God, calling God a liar. Eve was deceived. She was left only to her senses no longer having God's word for her guidance, the only thing she had left was her senses. Eve had lost all protection of God's word, she had no spiritual resources left that she could rely on.

Gen 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat

At the time of any temptation we can still change our minds. A temptation is not a doubt.

Eve had lost Gods word in her thoughts; this was where her strength that comes from God was. When we rely upon the sense knowledge that that we receive from our flesh, and not the knowledge that comes from the spirit which we have from God we are lost.

Phil 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengthenth me; The scripture says thru Christ not thru our selves. Eve ate and died (I'll Get back to this.) she then gave to Adam who not being deceived, he chose Eve over God, also ate and died.

1 Ti 2:14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression. Adam then ate and condemned the world of men and women to separation from God. – Spiritual death upon men and woman until the reparations are made for the sins of mankind.

God's word does not just say that God created man in his own image. It also says that God formed man out of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul.

The Hebrew words for living soul are Nephesh for soul and chay for alive. In **Gen 1:21** God uses this same word for **great whales, and every living creature that moveth,** Look it up, this is not the life that God manifested in Ephesians.

We were dead in trespasses and sins. But it is not until we have Gods spirit in side of us that God considers us alive. We were quickened with Christ.

Col.1:27 It is Christ in us the hope of glory

Mat 4: 4 we live by Gods word;

Rom 8:33 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.;

11cor 13:4 For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God;

Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.(it is the Christ in us that God counts as alive);

1 cor 15:44-49 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. (sown natural, natural has live but not of God. raised spiritual, not the same life.) 45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. (Jesus Christ is called Adam by God, He came to fix what Adam messed up) 46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. 47 The first man is of the earth, earthy; the second man is the Lord from heaven. 48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly. 49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly

(The image of God is spirit John 4:24 God is a spirit);

Gal 5:25 live in the spirit (not in the flesh);

1 pet 4:6 For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. (Gospel preached to them that are dead, they had to be alive in the flesh and blood to hear it. Get born again!!);

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. 8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

1 John 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. (live by the spirit, people were walking and talking before Christ but in Gods eyes that was not enough);

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life;

Isaiah 43:7 Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. (are you called by the name of God? What name were you called by before you were born again?)

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness (John 4:24 God is a spirit) vrs 27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them

1 thes 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (here Paul prays about three parts, spirit, soul and body.)

In Gen. God created man in his image. (This would make God Adam and Eves spiritual father because they came out of God thru creation) The image of God is spirit. Spirit has no form that can be seen with our eyes. We cannot touch it; our senses cannot tell it's there. God also formed man out of the dust of the ground. Breathed into mans nostrils the breath of life and he become a living soul. Our body has a form, it has a shape, we can see it, we can feel it, and our senses know that it is there. It's life is earthly, a living soul. This would make God Adam and Eves father of their flesh because God gave them both breath life.

Gen 2:16 God talked to man, He gave them instructions. How did God talk to them? Like He talks to the saints today? Like He talked to Jesus Christ? Like He talked to the prophets of old? There are many examples in God word of how God talks to his chosen people by revelation. This is God's talking directly to the spirit that He has put upon who He is talking to. God talks to our spirit and our spirit talks to our mind. Our spirit is our translator between us and God.

Gen 41:38 Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the spirit of God is?

Ex 28:3 whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom;

Ex 31:3 And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;

2 Ki 2:9 Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.;

Is a 42:1 I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles;

Isa 61:1 The spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me

Eze 11:24 Afterwards the spirit took me up, and brought me in a vision by the Spirit of God into Chaldea, to them of the captivity. So the vision that I had seen went up from me. 25 Then I spake unto them of the captivity all the things that the LORD had shewed me.

Mat 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: 17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

John 1:33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost. 34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.

Gen 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. Adam and God had a relationship; this took them spending some time together and it took some talking to each other. God gave Adam dominion over all the living things on the earth and gave him something to do.

Gen 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. (God gave Adam a job, not only did Adam have charge over all the animals Adam had to take care of the garden of Eden);

Gen 2:15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the Garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it;

Gen 2:24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. (more instructions, this is quite a relationship);

Gen 2:25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed. (They were still in the way God formed, made and created them. When God does something he does it perfectly, they were perfect. They did what God instructed them to. They have no knowledge of sin or no thoughts of rebellion against God. Sin always starts in the thoughts and slays us. They had no knowledge of sin.);

Gen 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

Now they both are using their senses. They have died spiritually; the spirit that was in them is gone. There is no more revelation knowledge, no more knowledge from the spirit. The only way to receive knowledge from God by our senses is for God to come into some form of concretion like a burning bush; a voice that can be heard with the ears, a hand that writes on the walls, the written bible.

Gen 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (Here they heard God with their ears);

Gen. 3:9 And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou (God knew where they were He just wanted them to talk to them and for them not to be afraid);

Gen 3:11 And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? (I didn't tell you that. Where did this knowledge come from.) look at this Adam is stuck using his senses to navigate by. As also was all of mankind until Christ was sacrificed for all of mankind. In the Old Testament God needed a man of God, a prophet that he put spirit upon so he could communicate with Israel. God used the prophets to Give His Word to us for our learning. Now we can talk directly to God (if we are born again) because of what Jesus Christ did for us.

Adam and Eve were born like Jesus and knew no sin...And like Jesus they had a choice. Jesus said to His father God Luke 22:41 And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed, 42 Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done. Adam took of the fruit also and did eat. Two choices are shown; Gods way as shown by Jesus Christ, and Adams way as shown in Genesis. Which one do you think had better results?

John 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Worship requires choice, this is how God set it up. Lucifer the morning star, Gods right hand angel had freedom of choice. He choose rebellion and wanted to be like the most high God. This caused a war in heaven where one third of the angels were cast out of

heaven. During the process of this war both the heaven that was and the earth that was were destroyed. This will happen again during the final war between lucifer and God.

Gen 1 starts out in verse 2 telling us how the earth became without form and void. The King James translation uses the word "was" a word that is not even the Hebrew language. They have the verb "to become" but not the verb "to be". This will happen again during the final war between lucifer and God.

Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else. (God talks about how he created the earth. The words "in vain" are the Hebrew word "tohuw" the definition being to lie waste. God did not create the earth this way but He formed it to be inhabited.

Gen 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. (First let's talk about the word was. Only the first word was in this verse is in the text. Whenever the KJV uses italics they are telling you that they put extra words into the English translation. This word was, is the Hebrew word "haw-yaw" this is the verb to be. It came to pass, become, has been and so on, all past tense. The words without form is the Hebrew word "tohuw" To lie in waste and the word void is the Hebrew word "bohuw" emptiness, void, waste - sound familiar? The earth was not unfinished but wasted. This is why God was able to tell Adam and Eve to replenish the earth.

Gen 1: 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth God knew before Lucifer sinned and became satan that he would sin and covered for Adam and Eve, Mans redemption, the saints in Christ and more. Foreknowledge happened before predestination.

Now all humans are born not of God the first time around. Adam and Eve were formed made and created by God the first time around. God made Adam and Eve able to have children. These children then have children who have children and so on. But still there is no spirit of God in man or woman until they are born of God.

1 Corinthians 15:42-49 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: 43 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power: 44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. 45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. 46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. 47 The first man is of

the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven. 48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly. 49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

There is spiritual life and earthly life, you know our life of the flesh is earthly. God has children each and every time we are born again. When we are born again we receive this life from God and it is spiritual life

11 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. The word for creature is the same word used for creation, Each one of Gods kids is a new creation. There was no sex involved for God to become our parent. But spiritually when God creates spiritual life inside of us we are Gods children.

Under the same rules satan has children also. They show up many times in Gods word. Every thing about them is against Christ and against God. They are anti-christs, not the anti-christ but of the same mold. These are the children satan has fathered. Satan does not create but through a counterfeit method satan gets permanent children that can never turn back. People who have confessed with their mouth and believed in their heart that satan is lord.

These are the soldiers of satan, they rise to great power in our earthly realm. Their purpose is to lead people away from the True God thru; lust, temptation, power. They are the vehicles that satan uses for his ministry which is steal, kill and destroy.

So what to do,

Ro 13:14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the lusts of flesh.

1Pe 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear.

Re 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives to the death.

There are three things to do here; Think the words of God's word, Speak of the words of God that are inside you, Testify of what God has done for you in all circumstances.

Live with this pattern in life!

Receive the word of God with meekness, Retain the word of God in your heart with conviction (hold onto it with all of your might), and release Gods word with boldness, shout it out.;

- 11 Timothy 4:1 I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;
- 2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.
- 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- 4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

We are the world's only chance to receive the live that is in Christ Jesus. We are the light of the world with the ministry of reconciliation in Christ's stead. Jesus was in this world reconciling the world unto Himself. Now He has given us that job.

- 11 Cor 5:16 ¶ Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.
- 17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- 18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
- 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
- 20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.
- 21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Now it is God in Christ in you the hope of glory. Can you ask for anything more?

Colosians 1:26 Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

One last thing, a man or woman with experience has a better argument that somebody with a good speech. Don't let the words spoken pull you away from what God has done for you.
