Rule #1: Have an upbeat, can-do attitude.

Present yourself as energetic and interested in the current work world. Never look, tired, defeated or out of place. Always look the staff in the eye and be engaging in your conversation.

Look the part... is Rule #2.

Make sure that you don't dress "old." Dress appropriately for your age in the current fashion. Make sure that your hair, makeup and accessories are modest. And keep the perfume and cologne to a minimum.

Rule #3: Live in the present, not in the past.

Whether you are just interviewing, or on the job, never refer to "the good old days" or say things like, "you are too young to remember that."

Limit your old stories or how you solved problems in the past. These activities remind everyone that you are a senior and may frustrate co-workers.

Rule #4: Promote your positive attributes.

When interviewing, talk about your work ethic and abilities. Let them know that you are more flexible with time and are able to adapt to different environments and get the job done. Use these rules and learn your Business SoftSkills and you will have an excellent opportunity to get a job. Remember, you were probably successful in earning a living before, and you can do it again.
