



## NEW FAMILY PRACTICE CLINIC TO OPEN EARLY NOVEMBER

Corpus Christi, TX (September 20, 2020) - A new family practice clinic will open early November in the Calallen area. Dr. Ron Guevara, a long-standing family physician who has cared for families in the Coastal Bend Area for over 20 years will leave Future Focus Family Medicine in late October and open his very own, named Texas Family Wellness Clinic (TFWC).

Guevara stated, "I'm very excited to be starting my own practice and I'm grateful to the patients that I've been able to serve thus far and look forward to continuing to provide top-notch medical care to the community and surrounding area."

TFWC will begin seeing patients on November 5, 2020 at their new facility located at 15406 Northwest Blvd., Ste. B, Robstown, Texas 78380. Patients eager to follow Dr. Guevara at his new clinic should call (361) 933-1188 to schedule their appointment.

Guevara commented, "I decided to open my own practice to spread my wings and blaze my own path. I've run my own clinic in the past and have always had an entrepreneurial spirit and now I'm in a position to realize that dream again with the support of my family by my side."

TFWC will offer a variety of services for the entire family, which include chronic disease management, annual wellness physical exams, well woman exams, and the treatment of minor and urgent health issues – to name a few. Patients will be required to make an appointment and may be seen the same day upon availability; however, walk-ins will not be accepted.

"I believe our approach to health and wellness will set us apart from other clinics because we will focus on lifestyle changes, in addition to utilizing both traditional & nontraditional treatments", Guevara added. The nontraditional services offered to patients will include nutritional assessments, vitamin & herbal supplements, laser therapy, allergy immunotherapy, and many other cutting-edge treatments.

TFWC will provide patients with a variety of resources to assist with their transition over to the new clinic and will accommodate busy families with convenient tools to handle all check-in tasks prior to their visit. "Our goal at Texas Family Wellness Clinic is to create an environment that gives the patient more time with the physician and less time at the front office signing paperwork. We've partnered with several vendors to offer the latest technology in patient relations to expedite their visit once they've arrived at our office," said Amie Guevara, Office Administrator for TFWC.

One of these many features will include Contactless Check-in with any smart device where patients can update their contact information, confirm or cancel their appointment, book an appointment, upload a photo of their insurance card, answer any preliminary questions about their health issue for the physician to review prior to their visit, and pay their copay before every stepping foot inside the clinic. Amie Guevara stated, "These

tools will free up staff and providers to really spend time with the patient and give them the care and attention needed to increase the level of care we all expect when seeing our doctor.”

Other resources offered by TFWC will include a patient portal, known as Healow and Telemedicine virtual appointments for established patients. New and established patients will also have the ability to book an appointment with Dr. Guevara online via the clinic’s website beginning October 1, 2020.

Amie Guevara added, “Everyone will be a new patient at the clinic. The process to move over to us could take up to two weeks, so it’s best that anyone wanting to see Dr. Guevara in November should start that process now”. The first step in becoming a patient will be to schedule an appointment. Once the appointment is on the books, the staff can then walk the patient through the process of having their medical records requested & completing any paperwork virtually prior to the first visit.

“Don’t wait until there is an issue to come see me, please schedule an appointment to just become established with us first to be sure we have all of your medical history documented accurately. We look forward to seeing you all in our new clinic,” said Dr. Guevara.
