**2019 Teacher Scholarship Application Package**

**Application Procedure**

Applicants must submit the following documents to the Selection Committee:

1. A completed application form.
2. An essay describing the reasons why you would be a worthy recipient of the Congress of Black Women of Canada, Mississauga and Area Chapter teacher Scholarship.
  - a. Include your contribution to the community, other volunteer activities, and what motivated your contribution.
  - b. Also include your academic achievements, your most important accomplishments and your future goals.
3. Two letters of reference.
4. Proof of graduation / date you will graduate.

**Selection Criteria**

- Demonstrated Financial Need
- Recognized volunteer contribution to the community
