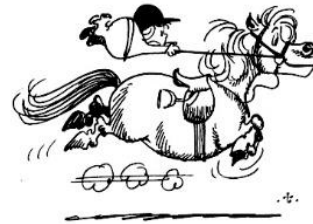

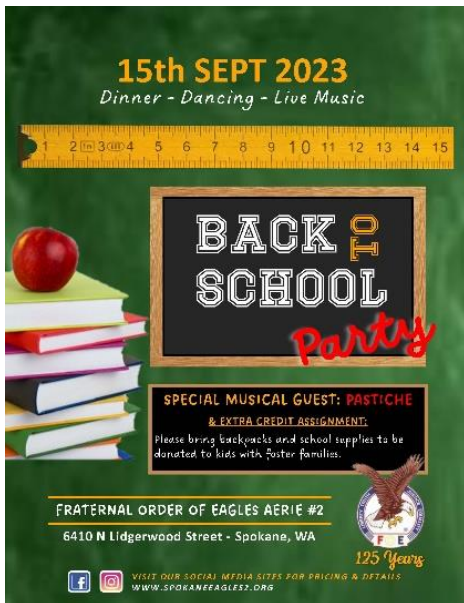

Lidgerwood. Our membership peaked at more than 10,000 members when we offered a gym, full-size swimming pool, racquetball and other recreational amenities. The old building became too expensive to maintain so it was sold. The new building cost 1.2 million, it’s address is 6410 N. Lidgerwood.

## September is PAD and Atrial Fibrillation Awareness Month

Atrial fibrillation is the most common type of irregular heartbeat and is a leading risk factor for stroke. Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) is a vascular condition related to heart disease and stroke.

What do they both have in common? They are both detectable with simple, painless screening.

This is why Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie 2 is hosting Life Line Screening, the nation's leading provider of preventive health screenings on Wednesday, September 6, 2023. The screenings provided focus on vascular disease, including atrial fibrillation and peripheral arterial disease.

Screenings are fast, painless and affordable. Three key tests check for blocked carotid arteries, atrial fibrillation, and high blood pressure, which are the three leading risk factors for stroke. Nearly 800,000 strokes will occur this year.
