Dementia Caring is a small locally based charity supporting people with dementia and their caregivers. We are currently seeking volunteers to help run our once-a-week Time Out Club. The club takes place every Wednesday morning at Elford Village Hall, Church Road, Elford, B79 9DA.

Tasks undertaken by volunteers include:

- Greeting and making attendees of the Time Out Club feel welcome;
- Interacting with people; being friendly and approachable; providing company; and helping those with dementia feel settled, safe and secure;
- Helping to establish, maintain and develop relationships with those with dementia and their caregivers;
- Providing one-to-one support where appropriate;
- Being involved with the planning, organising and staging of a range of activities including table top games; arts and crafts; exercise and games;
- Providing help with domestic tasks such as serving refreshments and washing-up; and
- Helping to set up the village hall as well as clearing up at the end of the day care session

Training will be available free of charge and undertaken throughout the year.
