Business Arising from Minutes:

Project Updates:

- Commercial Street
 - \$6,900.00 has been budgeted for benches
 - \$10,687.07 has been budgeted for receptacles
 - John was directed to requisition the benches and receptacles
 - The irrigation system (not budgeted for) has been deferred and will be included in the 2021-2022 capital budget
 - Gerard was directed to cost out the irrigation system

Founding Fathers Park

- Work for this fiscal year has concluded
- The Group will commence discussion for Phase #3 for the park in the coming months

Grant Funding

- The expenses for the \$13,861 beautification grant received by the Municipality will need to be finalized at year end
- As part of the grant, the Village agreed to match the funding with additional investments of \$13,861
- Remaining items that need to be expensed include the aforementioned benches and receptacles, as well as pavers (\$6,703.00) and labour for the floral install at the Roundabout (\$3,000)
- This may leave a small amount of grant funding for an additional investment, which the Group can discuss, once numbers become more formalized

Lockhart-Ryan Park Signage

- \$632.50 has been allocated for a 4'x8' sign
- Mary will contact Michael Gabriel to work on a design for the sign for Lockhart-Ryan Park

Roundabout

- Gerard was directed to contact the Briar Patch to obtain an estimate on the labour for installation of the plan and shrub order for the Roundabout
- \$3000 has been allocated for labour for this purpose
- The labour needs to be invoiced prior to March 31, 2021
- The Group did discuss that the shrubs and trees may supplant the need for a Christmas tree at this location

New Business:

- 101 Highway Sign
 - Gerard has obtained an updated cost estimate of \$12,500 for a new highway sign for the west end of the New Minas section of the 101 Highway
 - This estimate includes a new sign as well as some modifications to the existing sign at the east end of the New Minas section of the 101 Highway
 - The accurate design has been provided to Transportation & Infrastructure Renewal
 - This item will be included in the upcoming Village capital budget for 2021-2022
 - It was recommended to add a \$1000 contingency to the estimate

Branding of Woodvale Tank

 Mary will solicit Michael Gabriel for a concept for the placement of updated branding for the New Minas Water Tower

• Priorities for 2021-2022

- Green initiatives, such as solar lights for holidays and other occasions were discussed as possible ideas
- John was directed to determine the dates for the Municipal beautification grants for next fiscal year and report back at the next meeting
- Capital Project ideas for 2021-2022:
 - Irrigation System for Roundabout
 - Sign for 101 Highway and Modifications to Existing Sign
 - Design & Branding of Woodvale Water Tank
 - Beautification of the Village's community parks
 - Hardware for 17 Holiday Banner placements
