
February 2024 - Block of the Month Monkey Wrench-Under Ground Railroad





## Materials Needed:

1. 2 colors of fabric, one dark (fabric A) and one light (fabric B)

## Cutting:

- 1. From each fabric cut (2) 5-1/2" squares
- 2. From each fabric cut (1) 12" x 2 5/8" wide strip
- 3. From fabric (B-light) cut one 2 5/8" square for the block center

## Instructions:

- Place one (B-light) and one (A-dark) 5 ½" square right sides together. Draw a line from top to bottom corner on the diagonal. Stitch 1/4" from this line on both sides of it. Cut squares apart on the line. Press to the dark side.
- 2. Trim the half square triangles you made in (step 1) to 4 ½" using a quilters' ruler. Place each at the 4 corners of your potential block with the dark points facing in.
- Stitch together the (2) 12" x 2 5/8" strips using a 1/4" seam. Press to the dark side. Cut (4) 2 5/8" segments from the strip set. Make sure that this is even.
- 4. Line up the components of your Monkey wrench as shown in the photo above.
- 5. Sew the sides together, making sure that the dark pieces line up correctly in the center. Press.
- 6. Sew the middle together. Press the seams toward the middle square.
- 7. Sew the middle to the sides, carefully lining up the central seams.
- 8. Press the overall block.
- 9. Trim to roughly 10 inches or the size you selected for your Log Cabin block from January.
