Instructions for bibs for Cedarcrest

1). Cut squares at least 20 inches - 22 if your fabric is wide enough. SQUARE is the operational word.

2). Turn and press a generous quarter inch on all four sides of cloth.

3). Take a washcloth-there's a great price on packages of them in colors as well as white at Walmart. Place it in a corner of the square on wrong side. Just up against the turned in edge on top and side and pin in place. Pin the inner corner of the wash cloth to keep it from moving.4). Fold the edges of the fabric to capture the 2 outer edges of the washcloth and continue turning in a quarter inch as you stitch all 4 sides of the bib.

5). Return to the last 2 sides of the washcloth and sew them to the bib fabric. Remember, your bobbin thread will be what's on the right side of bib.
