

Batik Cutting Bee

We are hoping to organize a cutting bee to be held during our quilt day on June 17th. We have done this in the past and it was very successful with all participants having a good time.

Participants will bring in 10- 1/2 yard pieces of Batik fabric; lights, medium and dark colors (5 total yards). We will all cut our fabric into 2 1/2" and 4 1/2" strips and then exchange the fabric . There is a quilt book entitled "Cutting Bee Quilts" with patterns which use these strips. Each participant will go home with the equivalent of 5 yard of fabric. The more people who participate the greater the variety of batiks each will go home with. Interested members will need to sign up.

Quilt Bingo

We will be playing 16 games and all prizes are quilted or quilt related items. Thank you to the members who have already signed up to make a quilt or item for the bingo prizes. The deadline for giving us your item for the bingo is **June 14th**, please keep this date in mind. If your item is finished before that, you can hand it at any time. Thank you to Shirley Correll for her 86" x 92" purple and green quilt, Kathy Parrish for four seasonal wall hangings and Judy Mehl for her wall hanging. The committee will use it's discretion, if we do end up with too many quilted items. Remember we have the Tricky Tray as well. 
