Fabric Exchange

It is not too late to sign up! You can sign up to participate tonight! The fabric squares will be exchanged at the August meeting. You will have to cut 60 five inch squares. To be able to cut 30 5"

squares you will need 5/8 of a yard of fabric. The squares do not to be cut from all the same fabric, it is fine to use your scraps. There are many quilt designs using 5" squares.

There will be a group for **Black/Red** and a group for **Yellow/Blue**, (the yellow will be a sunshine yellow and the blue a delft blue, do not use light blues or navy). You may sign up for both groups if you would like. The sign up sheet will be available at this meeting. See Lorraine Hare
