The Treasurer's Report as printed in the newsletter was accepted by Sheri Seip, seconded by Donna Conto with all in favor. The Secretary's Report was not available. Lois reminded everyone to bring an item to the Christmas Party for our annual raffle/tricky tray. Members suggested the following charities for the raffle to benefit: Street 2 Feet (a homeless charity); Women's Resources; Valor (a veteran's shelter); or Student Book Club Library for Stroudsburg Junior High School.
