

**RESOLUTION TO PROCEED TO LEVY A  
TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**

Resolution No. 2022-0607-02 (Additional Police Tax Levy 3.0 mills)

The Board of Trustees of Smith Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 7th day of June 2022, at the office of said Board, with the following members present:

Trustee Larry Barnett  
Trustee Terry Criss  
Trustee Scott Showalter

Trustee Barnett moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, on the 3rd day of May, 2022, the Board of Trustees passed and adopted Resolution No. 2022-0503-08 declaring the necessity, for the purposes set forth in RC\$505.50, and RC\$5705.19(J), to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation under RC \$5705.03, RC \$5705.19(J) and RC \$5705.191 at the rate of 3.0 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.03 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mahoning County Auditor has certified to the Board of Trustees that the dollar amount of revenue to be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection is \$ 262,796., based upon the current assessed valuation of the Township of \$87,598,580. therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of Smith Township, Mahoning County, Ohio, all members elected thereto concurring, that the Board desires to proceed with the submission of the question of an additional tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit

of Smith Township, to the electors of Smith Township pursuant to pursuant to RC \$505.50, RC \$5705.03, RC \$5705.19(J) and RC \$5705.191 for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings, used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, for the payment of the costs incurred by townships as a result of contracts made with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection, for the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department, or for the payment of other related costs, at a rate not exceeding 3.0 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.03 for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five (5) years, commencing tax year 2022 collection year beginning 2023, which tax will be voted upon and levied on the total unincorporated area of Smith Township, which is wholly located in Mahoning County, Ohio.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the provisions of said tax levy be submitted to the electors of said Smith Township, in the general election to be held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 2022; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that said tax levy be submitted to the electors under the authority of Ohio Revised Code, Sections 5705.03, 5705.19(J) and 5705.191; and


**RESOLVED** that the Fiscal Officer of this Board of Trustees of Smith Township be, and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Mahoning County, Ohio, not less than ninety days prior to the election and notify said

Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.


