E6 604	C26/III	David Blythe, Jr	D4/22/1849. Grandson of Ezra E6 600;C23. An artist. Painted "Battle of Gettysburg".
D5 449	C30/IV	Sarah Slemmons.	B1720-D1/31/1810. Mother of Rev Slemmons.

According to newspaper claim, Jennie and Alexander II buried in D544 C-45. Jennie (1784-1855) married James St Clair, Jr (1775-1855), could be son of General Alexander St Clair, Sr. a Rev War veteran. She was daughter of Rev Slemmons (D5 438;C-41). Source: Daughters of American Colonists DAC #11205. Indicates Jenny married to James St Clair.

John Crawford D5 445 D12/27/1771. Father of Jane Crawford who married Hugh Dinwoody II, D1777 (1962-1966 book indicates both John Crawford D5 445 and Thomas D6 450 and John Paxton D6 441 buried in C46. New book clears up discrepancy).

D6 455 C49/VII Margaret (White) Paxton B8/23/1825 D4/20/1895. Wife of John B. Paxton D6 456 B8/23/1825 D4/20/1891 (Exact date of death in question). Married 1/10/1854. Daughter of Thomas White, Jr (1796-1832) and Margaret (McClellan). Married 6/22/1820. B1794 D10/9/1850. Thomas White, Sr (B2 91;D53) was Capt in 2nd Co, 7th Btn 1778 at Valley Forge with Thomas Church Co. 1777-1778.

1. David (1740-1831) Rev War veteran (E6 601;C-24). From Fife Shire, Scotland.
2. David (?-1849) E6 604 Private in Army. Was in War of 1812.
3. David (1815-1865). Burial unknown. Grandson of Senator Ezra Blythe (E6 600;C23) and wife Sarah (McKesson) (E6 599;C22). David was an artist and painted the "Battle of Gettysburg".
