

### Fiscal Year End 2021-2022

As of 6/30/22, we have 1,267 registered families of Holy Name of Jesus. 507 (40.02%) of families contributed \$0.00 this fiscal year. The average contribution of families who gave (760) financially this fiscal year was \$2,017.80.

### Fiscal Year End 2020-2021

As of 6/30/21, we had 1,293 registered families of Holy Name of Jesus. 597 (46.17%) of families contributed \$0.00 this fiscal year. The average contribution of families who gave (696) financially this fiscal year was \$2,455.00.

### EXPLANATIONS OF PARISH FUNDS: THEIR USES AND HOW THEY ARE FUNDED

The Parish Operating Fund: This account pays for the normal operations of the parish, providing for salaries, benefits, utilities, phone bills, postage, and computer services as well as routine maintenance such as mowing, snow removal, waxing floors, light bulbs, and filters. In addition, it pays all expenses necessary to operate the many ministries available in the parish. The Parish Operating Fund account is funded by collections. Annually, a budget is prepared based on an estimate of the operating expenses and this determines the amount needed in collections for the coming year. It is through these collections that the many ministries are made possible.


**The Parish Plant Fund:** This account pays for capital expenditures. Capital expenditures are items for all properties: church, school, St. Margaret Chapel, convent, including building repairs and improvements, land and parking improvements, possible land purchases, large furniture and equipment repairs and purchases. A "plant fund" monthly envelope is provided however these larger items required additional funding. The parish is depended upon receiving estates and memorials for these major expenses.

<u>The Cemetery Fund:</u> This account pays for all expenses of the St. Louis Cemetery. These expenses would include: lawn maintenance, road improvements, and landscaping, fencing, and computer expenses. The cemetery is self-supporting. As to date, the sale of grave spaces have been enough to maintain the property.

**Food Pantry:** This investment account is solely for maintaining the food pantry. Withdraws are made annually for the amount needed to purchase food for the pantry.

**Settlement Value July 2021:** The Plant Fund Value June 2022:

The cash is held in a Diocesan Savings account earning 1.5% compounded quarterly. Diocese Assessment paid on Settlement, July 2021 (10%) \$681,369.67. Diocesan Assessment paid on 3 tracts of farmland sold, \$289,629.68. Proceeds restricted by Herman Alles' will to be used for future maintenance & building projects for Holy Name Parish.
